

NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS ARE MANDATED BY LAW.

Children must be excluded from school if they do not meet these requirements.

FULL COMPLIANCE

For all students in Grades 6 thru 12

Current complete physical examination (less than one (1) year old).

A child’s immunization history must include all of the following vaccines to be considered fully immunized.

<u>Grades 6 – 12</u>	<u># of Doses</u>
DTaP, DTP, DT, TD (tetanus-diphtheria).....	4 (NYC)
Tdap Booster(Adacel or Boostrix)	1
OPV or IPV.....	3
MMR.....	2
One dose on or after the 1 st birthday, plus a second dose of a measles-containing vaccine (preferably as MMR) administered 28 days or more after the first dose and at or after age 15 months.	
Hepatitis B.....	3
Varicella.....	2*
One dose on or after the 1 st birthday.	
*Although only 1 dose of vaccine is required, the recommendation is for <u>all</u> children to receive 2 doses of varicella-containing vaccine.	
Haemophilus Influenzae Type B (Hib).....	1
(One dose on or after age 15 months)	

NOTE: if a child was born in a high TB incidence area, such as Africa, Asia, Latin America or Eastern Europe, or has stayed in any of the aforementioned areas for 30 or more days, a test for TB infection should be administered and documented.
